Expectations of Serving on the Virginia Vale Board

- Per the bylaws, board members are elected by the membership to a two-year term during the annual meeting each August. Board members may serve no more than three consecutive terms.
- The Board meets for 1.5 hours 8-9 times per year. Board members are expected to attend all meetings and may be removed from office for missing three meetings in a 12 month period.
- Board members are expected to attend and work at 2 of 3 annual events: new member night at the start of the season, July 4th, and the Annual Meeting & BBQ at the end of the season.
- In addition to the general responsibilities outlined in the bylaws, each board member has specific roles and responsibilities which may adjust annually to meet the current priorities of the club and the skills and interests of board members.
- An average overall time commitment is 4-8 hours/week during the season (May through August) and 4-8 hours/month during the rest of the year. These are general guidelines and vary based on role.
- In return for service to the membership, a portion of board members' annual dues are waived during their tenure.

- A commitment to service on behalf of the member families
- Expertise in areas essential to the functioning of the board and the pool
- Respect and support for the management, staff, and coaches that run the day-to-day operations
- A commitment to working in a cooperative and respectful environment
- A commitment to serving with honesty, integrity, and high ethical standards
